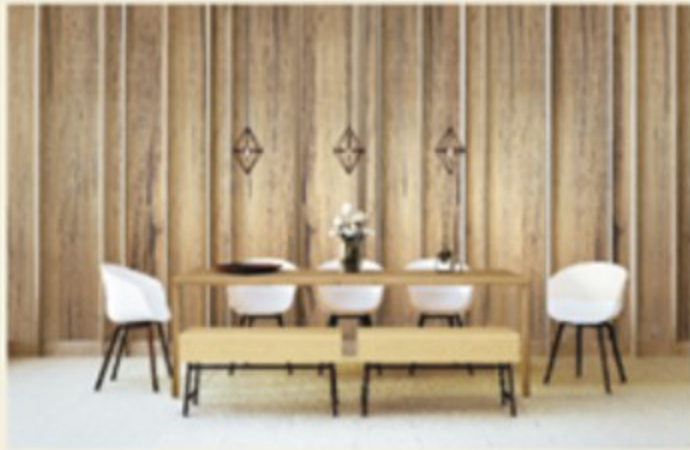


'Tis the season!
